

## LAMB JUMPER PATTERN

To be knitted in 8 ply washable acrylic wool using 4mm or 4.5mm needles. Pattern needs approximately 1 ball per jumper.

### For the back:

Cast on 48 stitches

Rib 20 rows

Stocking stitch 20 rows

Cast on 10 stitches and the end of the next 2 rows

Rib 20 rows.

### For the front:

For girl lambs - same as for the back!

For boy lambs - do only 6 rows in the stocking stitch part.

### To finish off:

Sew up side seams.

The boy's fronts are 16 rows shorter so they don't wet them!

Sew up the shoulder seams, leaving about 12-15cm wide gap for the neck.
